

MANAGEMENT, BUSINESS ANALYTICS - INFORMATION SYSTEMS CONCENTRATION, MSM

Any graduate business courses for a total of six credits. Full-time students are required to enroll in an internship or co-op in their first year. 6

Total Hours 30

The Master of Science in Management, Business Analytics - Information Systems Concentration allows students to concentrate their study of Business Analytics within the foundation of Information Systems. Because of the complex nature of the MS Management specializations, they typically go beyond optional concentrations in traditional MBA programs. They are designed for individuals who know what they want to do or to help them apply what they already know more effectively. The 30 credit program includes the Business Analytics, which is 12 credits, the Information Systems core which is 12 credits, and six credits of electives. Full time students are required to enroll in an internship or Co-Op in their first year.
