Certificate in Police Leadership (380023C)

The Certificate in Police Leadership is designed to provide advanced police studies education and preparation for promotional assessments for current and aspiring police supervisors and managers. The program combines topics covered in state and national police leadership programs with a comprehensive exploration of the social science research on policing. The Certificate will help leaders develop the data-driven and evidence-based decision-making tool kit that is necessary for success in this demanding career path.

The Certificate in Police Leadership is a stand-alone certificate. Students are not required to enroll in a degree program.
